- Human and civil rights issues
- Teamwork, cooperation, collaboration, service to others
- Empowerment of the disenfranchised
- Innovation and education

**Participants must show evidence of how any number of these criteria is evident in their lives, and correlate that experience to the work of César Chávez.**

### Awards Program Rules:

1. Applications for all César E. Chávez Memorial Education Awards Programs **must** be postmarked by **March 23, 2007**.
2. Winning essays and artwork will be placed on display at an appropriate location.
3. Photographs of projects not accepted – original items only.
- \* 4. Persons eligible: A CTA member may submit up to 5 entries. Each entry may be for an individual student or a group of no more than 5 students (K – Community College).
5. **Please do not submit more than five group entries.**
6. An application form must be submitted for and with **each** entry.
7. CTA Members are encouraged to submit quality work.
8. **Applications that do not meet all specifications will not be considered.**
9. **Written Essays - NO BIOGRAPHIES. Submissions that do not meet the criteria addressed by the project will not be evaluated. (See Above)**
