Important Notes:

- 1. Required Attendance: Elected delegates must be available to attend the entire event and all meetings and activities.
- Election Process: A ballot will be sent to all CTA Aspiring Educators with the name and statement of all those who have declared candidacy and have been determined eligible to run.
- Number of Available Seats: The number of elected delegates that CTA Aspiring Educators may send will depend upon our statewide membership on March 15, 2024.
- 4. Cost: Expenses for elected delegates to attend both the NEA RA and the NEA Aspiring Educators Conference are covered by CTA and CTA Aspiring Educators. Additional participants may attend at their own expense. More about the NEA Representative Assembly (RA): The National Education Association (NEA) holds an annual Representative Assembly convention of tits members every summer. This is the largest assembly of people for a single convention in the United States. Delegates elected from each state will attend the convention, vote on national issues, and elect national officers. In addition, elected student delegates also attend a preconference prior to the convention - the NEA Aspiring Educators Conference. This is a great opportunity to attend meetings and events as well as network with future and current educators from across the country.
