Dear Aspiring Educators,

Reflecting on the recent local and national elections, we feel urgency and hope. The path forward is clear: We must channel our collective energy into shaping an educational system that empowers students and strengthens the fabric of our democracy.

Through our coordinated efforts, union educators across the state made an undeniable impact. Together, we knocked on over **500,000 doors**, helping to swing crucial races from school boards to battleground congressional seats. At our **Fall Event**, we connected with over **1,000 households** and held **200 meaningful conversations** to secure the election of two dedicated, pro-public education school board members. Many of our fellow CTA members have stepped into leadership roles, winning positions on school boards and other elected offices. This is the power of solidarity in action. At the national level, the challenges ahead are daunting. Policy changes threaten to defund schools, promote vouchers, and marginalized voices in education. But with challenge comes opportunity. We believe in educators' resilience, our communities' unity, and our students' promise. We will fight to defend what matters most—our public schools, our right to inclusive education, and our shared commitment to equity and opportunity for all. Together, we say: THIS is what democracy looks like.

However, our membership has concerns about the role of political engagement in our mission. Let us be clear: the classroom and the ballot box are deeply connected. Political decisions shape our resources, the policies we teach under, and the future our students inherit. Advocacy isn't a departure from our educational mission—it is an essential part of it.

Now is the time to amplify our voices and grow our movement. When shared with others, hesitancy can become courage, and advocacy catalyzes transformation. 
