Members, through attending in-person conferences or watching on-demand trainings via the CTA Virtual Pass to online learning, can accumulate the professional growth hours needed to qualify for CTA-paid university units through our partner CSU, Chico. The accumulation of university units may allow CTA members to advance on their district salary scale. The average salary increase for members that have participated in the program is over \$3,500/year.
