Messages to Amplify

- » Prop. 3 will permanently extend a voter-approved tax on the wealthy to continue providing vital funding to California's public schools and community colleges.
- » Public schools and community colleges received more than \$14.6 billion last year in this funding and \$119 billion since it was first approved in 2012.
- » A YES vote on Prop. 3 permanently continues these critical funds for our schools, which have allowed us to make transformative investments in our students including universal transitional kindergarten and community schools and avoid deep cuts to the people and programs our students need.
- » Failing to pass Prop. 3 and extend this funding would mean an immediate 15% cut to funding for public schools and community colleges, with one in every six educators potentially losing their jobs.
- » Prop. 3 will not raise taxes on anyone – it extends the current tax applied to couples earning more than \$740,000 a year.
- » Voters have a simple decision in November: Vote YES on Prop. 3 to continue crucial funding for our public schools and invest in California students or cut taxes for the rich.

WHAT IS PROPOSITION 3?

Prop. 3 is a permanent extension of Proposition 30 and Proposition 55. These propositions were passed overwhelmingly by voters in 2012 and 2016. If we do not pass Prop. 3 in November, billions in existing funding for public schools will expire in 2030 so that the wealthy can get another massive tax break.
