

VOTE NO ON THE COSTLY RECALL

It's Expensive and Unnecessary

This special election is a waste of \$276 million of taxpayer money, which could have been used to support students, schools, and families instead of an unnecessary election. The next election for Governor is only a year away.

Recalls should be used when an elected official has committed a crime or major ethical abuse, not just because some people are unable to accept their election losses.

It's a Reckless Power Grab

The recall is being pushed by the same people who are suing to stop rules requiring masks, testing, and other safety measures in schools. With the Delta variant spreading, we need to reject these extreme efforts to undermine school safety.

The recall is funded by anti-public-school millionaires, including former Education Secretary Betsy DeVos, who want to cut funding from public schools and are pushing a school voucher initiative to divert taxpayer money from public schools.

The recall is funded by anti-union millionaires who want to lower wages, eliminate health care, weaken workplace safety laws, defund public education, and eliminate union jobs.

How will the recall election work?

All California voters will receive a ballot in the mail with two questions: Will the Governor be recalled, and who will replace him?

If a majority vote yes on the recall, the candidate with the most votes becomes California's new Governor.

It is possible for the winner to receive less than 50% of the votes.

By Mail: Mail-in ballots must be postmarked by Sept. 14.

Drop Off: Drop off your mail-in ballot at any time at your county elections office, any vote center, polling place, or ballot drop-off location by 8:00 PM on Sept. 14.
