

# 2022-2023 Scholarship for Members

## **Eligibility**

- 1. Be an active member of CTA (including members working on an emergency credential).
- 2. Applications must be submitted online by **Friday**, **January 27**, **2023**. A complete application consists of the online application and two recommendation forms.
- 3. College coursework should demonstrate high academic achievement. Explain any unique circumstance related to medical, physical or emotional difficulties which may have affected your grades.

**Note:** ESP (Education Support Professional) applicants refer to the applicant's statement directions.

## **Evaluation of Applications**

1. Scholarships are awarded based on:

Applicant's Statement	50 pts	
School and Community Activities	20 pts 🗦	70%
Recommendation Form #1	15 pts ๅ	
Recommendation Form #2	15 pts	30%
	100 pts	

- Points will be deducted if the guidelines are not followed.
- 2. Recommendation forms must separately address both statements below:
  - Involvement in human, social and/or civic issues that reflect responsibility, reliability and integrity.
  - Educational and personal achievements that reflect academic and/or vocational potential.
- 3. Applications are read in their entirety by the CTA Scholarship Committee. The applications with the highest cumulative scores will be recommended as scholarship recipients.



## 2022-2023 CTA Scholarship for Members

#### **Scholarship Awards**

- 1. CTA receives approximately 75 -100 applications in this category annually. A maximum of five scholarships of up to \$3,000 are awarded.
  - ☑ One scholarship is designated as the American Indian/Alaska Native Memorial Scholarship in Honor of Alice Piper and is awarded to the highest-scoring member applicant.
- 2. Scholarship applicants are notified by mail in May. To receive funds, scholarship recipients will be required to submit an official verification of enrollment for the summer or fall 2023 semester/quarter as:
  - A half or part time student in an accredited institution of higher learning; or
  - Registered in an approved credential or degree program in an accredited institution of higher learning.
  - Registered in an approved technical training or certificate program if the applicant is an ESP member.
- 3. Scholarship funds must be used for education-related expenses only.

- Choose carefully the two people that will be completing the recommendation form. Select those that know you best and can address both statements. Judges are looking for <u>situations/examples</u> that demonstrate achievement in both statements.

Incomplete and late applications will <u>NOT</u> be considered.
