*An order signed June 27, 2022, prevents any information, including medical records and patient data, from being shared by state agencies or departments in response to inquiries or investigations brought by other states or individuals within those states looking to restrict access.

Our mothers, daughters, partners, sisters and friends should have the freedom and right to determine their healthcare and to make deeply personal decisions on their own, a fundamental human right. Our freedom to make personal and private decisions, not just about our health but also about our families and our lives, is at risk with the recent Supreme Court decision."
