



Special Election CTA/NEA-Retired Board and State Council Representative

The CTA/NEA-Retired Board and State Council Representative position requires significant commitment of time and effort. These duties include, but are not limited to, State Council committee obligations, Board meetings, SCC meetings, local Retired and Active chapter meetings, Planning Sessions, member recruitment, new chapter development, and addressing concerns and issues of individual members are all part of the job.

Nominations for CTA/NEA-Retired Board and State Council Representatives are conducted according to the Open Nominations procedure. This procedure holds that every eligible CTA member shall have the opportunity to nominate any CTA/NEA-Retired member who meets the qualification for office.

CTA/NEA-Retired Board and State Council Representatives: A candidate must be a member of the CTA/NEA-Retired, and must reside in the retired electoral district s/he is elected to represent.

In the event there are no declaration of candidacy forms received for a position, the election will be held with a write-in provision on the ballot for that respective position.

CTA/NEA-Retired Board and State Council Representatives are elected by a **plurality** vote.
