



SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS

Educational scholarship grants offer financial support to CTA members and their dependents throughout the academic year.

Grants for CTA members and chapters to demonstrate what teachers can do when they have the freedom to create and invent.

CTA Scholarship for Members

Scholarships up to \$3,000 each to active CTA members completing college coursework.

CTA Scholarship for Dependent Children

Scholarships up to \$5,000 each to dependent children of active, retired or deceased CTA members.

CTA Scholarship for Dependent Children in Honor of Del A. Weber

Scholarships up to \$5,000 each to a dependent child of an active, CTA/NEA-retired or deceased CTA member who is attending or attended a continuation high school or an alternative education program.

Aspiring Educator Scholarships in Honor of L. Gordon Bittle

Scholarships up to \$5,000 each to student members who have demonstrated high academic achievement.

Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Scholarship Program

Scholarships to encourage BIPOC students to become educators, school nurses, school counselors or school therapists and to promote professional growth for BIPOC educators and Education Support Professionals (ESP) members.

LGBTQ+ Safety in Schools Grant & Scholarship Program in Honor of Guy DeRosa

Grants and scholarships to support groups, projects and presentations that promote understanding of and respect for LGBTQ+ persons as well as for selfidentified LGBTQ+ members enrolled in a teacher/ counseling credential or graduate program who are pursuing a career in public education.

AWARDS

Awards include outstanding social justice and human rights work, effective communications by and for local chapters, excellence in media coverage, local political action and more.

Human Rights Awards

Given annually to CTA members, chapters and service center councils to celebrate the diversity of racial equity and social justice work that CTA members create, challenge and participate in.

César E. Chávez and Dolores Huerta Education Award Program

Recognition for educators and their students who demonstrate an understanding of the vision and guiding principles embraced by César Chávez and Dolores Huerta.




