Entries must focus on one or more of the following and show which principles of César E. Chávez's legacy affect your life:

- Principles of nonviolence
- Self determination through unionization (forming and joining unions)
- Social justice for farmworkers
- Safe food/health/environmental issues
- Human and civil rights issues
- Teamwork, cooperation, collaboration, service to others
- Empowerment of the disenfranchised
- Innovation and education

For written essays, participants must show evidence of how one or more of these criteria is evident in their lives and correlate their experience(s) to the work of César Chávez.

Awards Program Rules

1. Applications for all César E. Chávez Memorial Education Awards Programs must be postmarked by **Friday, March 15, 2019.**
2. Winning artwork will be placed on display at the CTA Headquarters building.
3. Photographs of entries not accepted – original items only.
4. The sponsor must be a CTA member employed at the same school or campus where the student is enrolled.
5. **Do not submit more than three (3) individual entries and only one (1) entry per student per year.**
6. An application form must be submitted for and with **each** entry.
7. CTA Members are encouraged to submit quality work. ***Please add any special circumstances for the committee to be aware of.***
8. **Applications that do not meet all specifications will be ineligible.**
9. For entries using chalk, artwork must be received with sealant to preserve the piece.
